Children, parents and neighbors are invited to join the party. And also the necessary officials, local leaders and representatives of the government. It was a succession of song, drama and dance by the children of the new school.



It was overwhelming! In addition, there were many speeches that made it clear what need this school meets. After the official unveiling of the sign by the guests of honor, the board members of the Hans and Anneke Foundation, there was a delicious lunch for all 300 guests. This day is a milestone in the CCP history that we all look back on with great joy and emotion.

A second family home has now been built on the grounds of the school next to the first guest house for children who do not have a safe home situation. This can be due to extreme poverty, but also due to situations of abuse and alcoholism. The new house offers space for up to 40 children and a mother.

More construction projects

In order to attract enough teachers for the schools and to ensure the permanent presence of the staff on the school grounds, 4 houses for teachers were also built. This was made possible by a great donation from the CATZ foundation. CATZ is a company from Barendrecht, specialized in the import of agricultural products.

Furthermore, 4 new houses were built for the poorest widows and their children. One of those houses was donated by the children of the Gideon School in Nieuwerkerk a.d. IJssel. The children have raised money for the house with the proceeds of the mission money of 1 year and through a card campaign in which the children have sold homemade cards. In addition to the house, the remaining amount raised was used to contribute to medical care for children and expenses for the annual school camp.

We are very happy that this project has worked out so well.

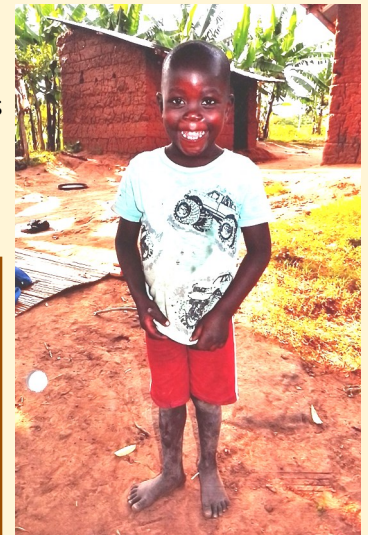
New board members
